



TECH TIP - Tandem Axle

Do You Know Your Tandem Axle?

The Meritor Inter-Axle Differential (IAD) is a driver-controlled, air-actuated traction device that allows for speed differences between the forward and rear tandem axles while providing equal pulling power from each axle of the tandem.

By activating the IAD switch located in the vehicle dash, improved traction is provided for each axle. The Inter-Axle Differential (IAD) is more commonly known as a "Power Divider" or "Third" differential.

Operation Tips

- The IAD is driver controlled.
- The IAD switch should be in the "UNLOCK" position for normal operating conditions where there is good traction.
- Lock the IAD when approaching or anticipating any loss of traction or poor driving conditions to provide improved traction.
- Always unlock the IAD when the need for improved traction has passed or when the vehicle is on a good traction road or highway.
- After locking or unlocking the IAD, let up on the accelerator to provide an interruption in torque to the drivetrain.
- Do not actuate the IAD switch while one or more wheels are actually slipping, spinning or losing traction, or damage to the axle can result.
- Do not spin the wheels with the IAD unlocked, or damage to the axle components could result.

Driver Instructions

When encountering poor road or highway conditions where a decrease in traction is anticipated, follow the recommended procedures:

- Flip the IAD switch to "LOCK" position while maintaining constant vehicle speed
- Let up momentarily on the accelerator. The differential lock will engage.
- Proceed to drive cautiously.

Do You Know Your Tandem Axle?

Unlocking the IAD Switch

When poor road or highway conditions have passed, follow these steps to UNLOCK the IAD:

- 1. Flip the switch to the "UNLOCK" position while maintaining vehicle speed.
- 2. Let up momentarily on the accelerator. The differential lock will promptly disengage.
- 3. Resume a safe vehicle speed.



The operator-controlled IAD switch is on the dash and is marked LOCK and UNLOCK.

LOCK IAD at any speed EXCEPT when one or more wheels are slipping, spinning or losing traction.



UNLOCK = GOOD TRACTION

Permits differential action between axles for all normal driving.

LOCK = POOR TRACTION

Straight through positive power to both axles. No differential action.



How to Operate the Inter-Axle Differential (IAD) Also Called Third Differential or Power Divider

LOCK the IAD Switch When Poor Road Conditions Threaten to Minimize Traction

DO	unlock IAD for normal operating condition when traction is good.		
DO .	lock IAD at any speed when you approach or anticipate poor road conditions where traction is at a minimum. IAD allows for speed differences between the forward and rear tandem axles, while providing pulling power from each axle of the tandem.		
DO	let up on the accelerator to interrupt drivetrain torque after locking or unlocking IAD.		
DO	unlock IAD when the need for improved traction has passed.		
DONT	ON'T lock IAD when one or more wheels are slipping, spinning or losing traction. You can damage an axle.		
DON'T	spin the wheels with IAD unlocked. You can damage an axle.



MERITOR SOCIAL

Sunshine North Primary School



In line with its commitment to social responsibility, Meritor Australia has been actively partnering with and supporting their local primary school, Sunshine North Primary for the last 5 years.

Sunshine North Primary is situated in the western suburbs of Melbourne and is a socially disadvantaged school* with a high immigrant/refugee population.

- The partnering occurs in 3 ways:
- 1. Due to economic issues, many children arrive at school without having had breakfast. Each Wednesday, 2 Meritor volunteers attend the school to help prepare and serve breakfast to the children. This not only ensures a nutritious start to the day, but also allows Meritor employees the opportunity to connect with the children and provide positive adult role modelling. Meritor also supplies financial support for the breakfast materials.
- 2. Each year the school conducts a 3 day school camp for their senior students (years 3, 4, 5 and 6). Traditionally there have been a number of children who have not been able to attend for a variety of reasons including financial, lack of confidence, etc. It has always been a concern to the School Principal that these children miss out and have to remain at the school. In 2017, financial support provided by Meritor and its employees allowed the school to hire mini buses to take these children to camp for 1 day to participate in the camp experience and spend
- the day with their classmates undertaking camp activities. As a result of this support, 2017 was the first year in the school's history that every eligible child was able to attend camp and, further, many of those children have now developed the confidence to attend the full 3 day camp in 2018. This support will continue in 2018 and beyond.
- **3.** As part of their cultural development program, the school has a music program where the children learn to dance, play musical instruments, etc. Often they don't have an audience to play to except themselves and their parents. Several times per year groups of schoolchildren performers attend the 2 Meritor sites in Melbourne to perform at communication sessions to the delight of our employees. The children then stay for a BBQ lunch with the Meritor team.

Meritor has also been pleased to be able to provide additional support as the need arises, including providing financial support for football jumpers and books for the library.

*310 students, over 200 families, over 140 families on EMA (Education Maintenance Allowance), 70 children are in single parent families, SFO .79 (a most highly disadvantaged school), 34 different languages spoken.
